

DANGEROUS GOODS CARRIED BY PASSENGERS AS CARGO, CHECKED BAGGAGE OR HAND-LUGGAGE



CONDITIONS:

Please contact with any Aura Airlines staff or Aura Airlines handling agent, at least 24 hours before your departing flight. Later petitions may be denied.

Passengers may carry dangerous goods as cargo, checked baggage or hand luggage, as per current regulations described in DGR of IATA and Technical Instructions of ICAO. Other limitations, quantities and products not included in those regulations, are forbidden.

In addition, Aura Airlines prohibits the transport of any explosive substances (only subdivision 1.4S is allowed), as well as radioactive material (class 7).

ACCEPTANCE OF DANGEROUS GOODS:

The Handling or Freightier agent will accept your dangerous goods as cargo (quantities, package...) according IATA and ICAO regulations, as well as according the limitations under Aura Airlines’s regulations.

Only those dangerous goods that requires the approval by Aura Airlines for its transportation, must be declared using this template. Refer to table 2.3.A of IATA DGR regulations.
